A Letter from the President



It's an exciting time of year at your Club. The golf season is about to get started, the Grill Room renovation is finished, and all of the Club's committees have been formed. Committees have been meeting and are bringing recommendations to the Board each month.

Last month, your Board approved the Finance Committee's recommended budget for the upcoming year. The Club just wrapped up a positive fiscal year, finishing with net revenue ahead of budget primarily due to the decisions made during the previous budget process and the attention paid by management to controlling expenses. This year, the budget includes 2% dues increase which is lower than last

year. The budget also includes a \$500 per member contribution to the capital improvement fund that can be paid over the same time frame as previous years.

This capital fund payment is lower than originally projected due to the work of management and the House Committee to complete the renovation of Grill Room under budget. During the shareholders meeting last November, the Board reported that the renovation would probably result in a capital fund contribution requirement of \$600 per member with the possibility that additional funds would be required for other expected capital expenditures. I'm pleased to report that even when the new deck is completed this spring, the project will cost much less than projected. The Club also received several generous donations toward the project. In summary, the 2019 capital improvement fund contribution will cover the renovation and some normal capital expenses that are required each year. This includes completing the approved capital project of fixing the bunkers and drainage around the #3 green. The work has started and should be wrapped up by early April.

The Spring Membership Campaign kicks off on April 1st. We hope this campaign will be as successful as last year. Also, don't forget to make your reservations for Easter Brunch early.

I hope to see you at the Club soon.
